‘Judging the Quality of Education!’

Based on the view that learning is a change to long-term memory, this course considers how a school can judge the quality of education and the resulting impact on how pupils are advancing their learning in the short-term.

During the day we will consider four key evidence-gathering activities:

- ◆ Lesson Visits
- ◆ Work Scrutiny
- ◆ Student Interviews
- ◆ Questions for Subject Leaders.

This will be looked at through a set of ‘lenses’ that will provide the foci for each activity:

- ◆ Assessment: sequencing and identifying gaps
- ◆ Checking: in-lesson assessment
- ◆ Feedback: effectiveness & teacher workload
- ◆ Teaching: teacher subject knowledge, presentation of subject matter, opportunity to learn
- ◆ Basics: vocabulary, English across the curriculum, role models
- ◆ Behaviour and attitudes: teacher expectations, classroom environment, student motivation.

By the end of the day, participants will have developed a toolkit of ideas and approaches to help them gather evidence about how classroom provision is enabling pupils to advance their knowledge and understanding across the curriculum, having shifted what is in the working memory to long-term memory.
